

The points stated by the Principal and Director during the meeting are mentioned underneath.

1. The Principal thanked the class representative for all the works they done in the committee, specially the third year CRs who would be leaving the college.
2. She said that the M.Com. 1st year result under autonomous status is already given.
3. Explaining the benefits of autonomous the Principal said that timely conduct of examination, skills development courses and certificate courses are possible under autonomous.
4. She emphasized on the overall development along with strong value and sustainable development approach.
5. She motivated the class representatives to be model to other students and also inculcate the same in the classmates.
6. The Director thanked all the class representatives for their cooperation and for being disciplined he owed the credit of all achievements of the college to the students.
7. He informed that though we have become autonomous but we would be under the banner of Devi Ahilya University, Department of Higher Education and AICTE.
8. Emphasizing on the benefits of autonomous, the Director said that our college will have a number of privileges. He said the students need to regularly check the college website and be updated as all the information regarding the exams and guidelines, time table etc. would be shared on college website. He added that no compromise will be done in the norms and guidelines.
9. The probable dates of 1st year examination would be from 3rd April to 18th April.
10. Introducing new certificate courses will be a part of curriculum and foreign collaboration we also be done next year.
11. As a part of autonomy, Experts and Principals of different colleges are the part of the Academic Council and different statutory bodies of our college and hence it would be beneficial for our students.
12. This year summer vacation project will be there and hence the students were requested to be in touch with the professors.
13. The Director said that the degree course is not enough and hence he encouraged the students for higher studies. he said that the students of SPIPS doing MBA from our college will be given special privilege and benefits.
14. The flying squad in the first-year examination would be from your city Director request the class representative to update it to the parents.
15. The Director informed the class representative that during the annual day celebration the best talent of the college would be given priority in order to respect the renowned personality and guest would be coming to the college. He requested all to be actively involved and shun the negative forces.
16. The Director showed delight and said that he is happy to see that the college is becoming student led.



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Then the Director invited the class representatives to give the feedback and suggestions.

1. CR Mr. Lokratna Divedi enquired about starting of MA and psychology as the major subject. The Director assured that the college is working on the same and as the college has become autonomous now so psychology would be taken as the major subject.
